# 2. Authority

#### 3. All Student Records to be Reviewed for Academic Progress

The records of all si denis, ho ha e failed to make sa lisfactor academic progress, ill be re ie, ed b the Fac lites all the end of semester or all the end of each ear as appropriate, or alls chother times as determined by the T m T ar a Akoranga Dep i Vice-Chancellor Academic.

#### 4. Criteria for Unsatisfactory Progress

- (a) The records of all rs<sup>1</sup> ear ndergrad a<sup>1</sup>e s<sup>1</sup> den<sup>1</sup>s ho ha e an o erall GPA of less <sup>1</sup>han 1.0 or ho ha e nolpassed half or more of the points in hich <sup>1</sup>he ere enrolled ill be re ie ed b <sup>1</sup>he rele ant Amo Dean a<sup>1</sup> the end of each semester, or a<sup>1</sup> the end of <sup>1</sup>heir rs<sup>1</sup> ear of s<sup>1</sup> d, as appropriate.
- (b) The records of all other indergrad are siden is, ill be relie, ed if:
  - i. in The ear nderre is and in The preceding ear in hich The ereenrolled The har eno Tpassed half or more of The points in hich The ere enrolled; or
  - ii. The ha e an o erall GPA of less Than 1.0 for Their degree le el sT d ; or
  - iii. The hare failed to demonstrate competence in professional requirements.
- (c) The records of an ndergrad are siden is, ill be re ie, ed if:
  - i. The hare ithdra n from more than half of the corrses in hich the ere enrolled in the preceding to ears of std; or
  - ii. The hare other ise failed to demonstrate an likelihood of s ccess.
- (d) The records of all sì den's enrolled in a Cerli cale of Pro cienc (COP), ill be re ie, ed al the end of each semester or teaching period.
- (e) The records of all st den's enrolled in Transition Programmes (CUP) ma be re ie ed at the end of each semester or teaching period.

# 5. Decisions on Academic Progress

- (a) After re ic\_ ing the record of a st dent, ident ed in Reg lation 4 abo e, one or more of the follo ing decisions ill be made:
  - i. That no action be taken;
  - ii. That The st dent be sent a letter gi ing ad ice to assist Them in impro ing Their academic performance, hich might incl de referral to The Te Pokap P kenga Ako Academic Skills Centre;
  - iii. That The st den the sent a letter arning that if their academic performance does not improe in the net period of their st d that f rther action, incl ding e cl sion from the q ali cation or the Uni ersit, ma be taken;
  - i. That the st dent be permitted to re-enrols bject to speci ed conditions, or restricted to a certain n mber of points, as determined by the rele and Amo Dean;
  - . That The st dent be declined enrolment for the ft re, or for sch ft re period as mabe specied, in a partic lar corse or corses, sbject, q ali cation or q ali cations.
- (b) A si denima noi be declined enrolmeni in a q ali cañon or the Uni ersi if the ha e noi alread recei ed a arning or conditional enrolmeni levier, e cepi, here the ha e failed to meet the req irements of the reg lations of the q ali cation.
- (c) A conditional enrolment letter ma incl de req irements that can lead direct to e cl sion from enrolment in a co rse, or co rses, s bject, q ali cation or q ali cations.
- (d) A si deni ho has been e cl ded from a q ali calion ma enrol in a second q ali calion onl in the appro al of the Amo Dean responsible for that second q ali calion.

(e) A si den the is considered for e cl sion from a second q ali calion ill be considered for e cl sion from the Uni ersil.

#### 6. Delegation of Decisions

- (a) Decisions, nder Reg la lion 5, it respect to conditional enrolments or e cl sion from ndergrad a le and grad a le q ali cations, or conditional enrolments or e cl sion from the Uni ersit, are made b the T m T ar a Akoranga Dep to Vice-Chancellor Academic, on the recommendation of the rele and Amo Dean.
- (b) Decisions, nder Reg la lion 5, lin respect to posigrad all q ali calions, are made b the T m T ar a Akoranga Dep l Vice-Chancellor Academic, on the recommendation of the rele and Amo Dean.
- (c) All other decisions nder Reg lation 5 are delegated to the rele and Amo Dean and ill be reported to the T m T ar a Akoranga Dep T Vice-Chancellor Academic.

#### 7. Power to Exclude a Student

- (a) For a sident alread enrolled in a q ali cation in hich the are latere cl ded, the decision related to their progression ill o erride their enrolment and their enrolment ill be cancelled b the T m T ar a Akoranga Dep i Vice-Chancellor Academic.
- (b) The T m T ar a Akoranga Dep 7 Vice-Chancellor Academic ill report to the Concil the n mber of st dents, ho have been declined enrolment in the Universit.

#### 8. Right of Re-admission after Exclusion

- (a) As i deni ho has been e cl ded from a co rse, s bjeci or q ali cañon ma applio i he rele ani Amo Dean for re-enrolment or re-admission after nolless i han 12 months after the e cl sion date, or i he n mber of da s speci ed in the e cl sion case.
- (b) A si den has been e cl ded from the Uni ersi ma appl othe T m T ar a Akoranga Dep i Vice-Chancellor Academic for re-enrolment or re-admission after notless than 12 months, or the n mber of da s speci ed in the e cl sion case.
- (c) A si denim si pro ide e idence of heir likelihood of s ccess in f i re ni ersi si dies.

# 9. Right of Appeal
