

1. The following are the rules for the Research Course:

1. Terms

The Research Course is a two-year course.

2. Objectives

- (1) To provide a broad background in the field of research.
- (2) To provide a thorough grounding in the research methods.

3. Structure

- (1) The course consists of the following subjects:
 - (a) Research Methods
 - (b) Research in the Field
 - (c) Research in the Laboratory
 - (d) Research in the Clinic
- (2) The course is divided into four semesters.
- (3) The first semester is devoted to the study of the research methods.
- (4) The second semester is devoted to the study of the research in the field.
- (5) The third semester is devoted to the study of the research in the laboratory.
- (6) The fourth semester is devoted to the study of the research in the clinic.

4. Examinations

- (1) The student must pass all the subjects in the course.
- (2) The student must pass the research project.
- (3) The student must pass the research report.
- (4) The student must pass the research presentation.
- (5) The student must pass the research viva.
- (6) The student must pass the research thesis.

5. Admission

The student must have a first class honours degree in a relevant field.

6. Fees

- (1) The student must pay a fee of £1000 per year.
- (2) The student must pay a fee of £500 for the research project.

7. Regulations

- (1) The student must attend all the lectures and seminars.
- (2) The student must submit all the assignments on time.
- (3) The student must pass all the examinations.
- (4) The student must pass the research project.
- (5) The student must pass the research report.
- (6) The student must pass the research presentation.
- (7) The student must pass the research viva.
- (8) The student must pass the research thesis.

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
