

7. Transfers of credit, substitutions and cross-credits

- () A student who has completed 60 credit hours in the first semester of the BE(Honors) program may transfer to the second semester of the BE(Honors) program.
- () A student who has completed 100-190 credit hours in the first semester of the BE(Honors) program may transfer to the second semester of the BE(Honors) program.
- () A student who has completed 400-180 credit hours in the first semester of the BE(Honors) program may transfer to the second semester of the BE(Honors) program.
- () A student who has completed 300 credit hours in the first semester of the BE(Honors) program may transfer to the second semester of the BE(Honors) program.

8. Progression

- () A student who has a GPA of 6.0 or higher in the first semester of the BE(Honors) program may progress to the second semester of the BE(Honors) program.
- () A student who has a GPA of 5.0 or higher in the first semester of the BE(Honors) program may progress to the second semester of the BE(Honors) program.
- () A student who has a GPA of 4.0 or higher in the first semester of the BE(Honors) program may progress to the second semester of the BE(Honors) program.
- () A student who has a GPA of 3.0 or higher in the first semester of the BE(Honors) program may progress to the second semester of the BE(Honors) program.

9. Engineering Honours

- () A student who has completed the BE(Honors) program with a GPA of 80% or higher may be eligible for the Engineering Honours program.
- () A student who has completed the BE(Honors) program with a GPA of 70% or higher may be eligible for the Engineering Honours program.
- () A student who has completed the BE(Honors) program with a GPA of 60% or higher may be eligible for the Engineering Honours program.
- () A student who has completed the BE(Honors) program with a GPA of 50% or higher may be eligible for the Engineering Honours program.

10. Exit and Upgrade Pathways to other qualifications

- () A student who has completed the BE(Honors) program with a GPA of 80% or higher may be eligible for the M.Sc. program.
- () A student who has completed the BE(Honors) program with a GPA of 70% or higher may be eligible for the M.Sc. program.
- () A student who has completed the BE(Honors) program with a GPA of 60% or higher may be eligible for the M.Sc. program.
- () A student who has completed the BE(Honors) program with a GPA of 50% or higher may be eligible for the M.Sc. program.
